1. Send \$12.00 with this notarized application. Make checks payable to "Hamilton County Clerk."

2. A notary desiring to make application for reappointment should apply to the County Clerk's Office eight weeks prior to the expiration of the previous commission.

3. After completing this application and returning it to the County Clerk's Office (625 Georgia Avenue, Room 201, Chattanooga, TN 37402), the County Commission will consider the application at its next scheduled bi-monthly meeting.

4. Upon notification by the County Clerk's Office that you have been approved as Notary Public for the State of TN, you must next secure a \$10,000 notary public surety bond payable to the State of TN. The term of the bond shall be four years beginning on the date of the issuance of the commission by the Governor. After securing the bond, you must appear with said bond in Room 201 of the Hamilton County Courthouse. A recording fee of \$2.00 will be assessed at that time.
